

Non-Licensable Work with Asbestos (UKATA)

Introduction

Asbestos is one of the biggest occupational health issues and kills around 5000 workers each year, which is greater than those who die through road traffic accidents in the UK. However, asbestos is not just a problem of the past. It can be present today in any building built or refurbished before the year 2000.

Course Duration

SSG offer this course over one day.

Who Should Attend

The Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012 states that 'every employer shall train those of his employees who are, or who are liable to be exposed to Asbestos or those who supervise/manage employees'. This could include but not be limited to carpenters, plumbers, maintenance workers, cable installers (phone, computer, alarms), shopfitters, demolition operatives, painters and decorators, architects or surveyors.

The Non-Licensable Work with Asbestos course trains those who knowingly will be working with Asbestos containing materials where that work is not classified as "licensable work with asbestos" as defined by The Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012. Typically referred to as non-licensable or notifiable non-licensable (NNLW) work as detailed in HSE guidance Asbestos Essentials (HSG210).

Prerequisites for Delegates

Essential: Delegates must provide a copy of their UKATA Asbestos Awareness certificate, which must have been completed within the six months prior to attendance on this course.

- Emergency procedures

Certification and Assessment

Delegates will carry out a written assessment in addition to being assessed on their input during the practical exercise and their feedback. Course certification lasts one year as there is a mandatory requirement with UKATA for annual refresher training. ID cards can be requested at an additional cost of £3.50 per delegate.
