Introduction

Asbestos is one of the biggest occupational health issues and kills around 5000 workers each year, which is greater than those who die through road traffic accidents in the UK. However, asbestos is not just a problem of the past. It can be present today in any building built or refurbished before the year 2000.

Course Duration

SSG offer this course over half a day.

Who Should Attend

The Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012, Approved Code of Practice states that refresher training should be given at least every year'. Therefore anyone who has carried out the Non Licensable Asbestos Works course will require this annual refresher. This includes a refresher of the Asbestos Awareness Syllabus. Delegates do not need to attend the Asbestos Awareness Refresher in addition to this course.

A skills analysis will be undertaken at the start of the course in order to confirm delegates attending have retained information from the original course and to ensure refresher training is sufficient.

Prerequisites for Delegates

Essential: All delegates must have previously attended the full UKATA Non-Licensable Work with Asbestos course and must supply certificates or evidence of this training prior to course commencing.

Certification and Assessment

Delegates will carry out a written assessment in addition to being assessed on their input during the practical exercise and their feedback. Course certification lasts 1 year as there is a mandatory requirement with UKATA for annual refresher training. ID cards can be requested at an additional cost of £3.50 per delegate.
