Introduction

ISO 45001 is an International Standard that specifies requirements for an occupational health and safety (OH&S) management system, to enable an organisation to proactively improve its OH&S performance in preventing injury and ill-health. ISO 45001 enables an organisation, through its OH&S management system, to integrate other aspects of health and safety, such as worker wellness / wellbeing. During our two-day, intensive course you will learn about the requirements of ISO 45001:2018 and how to deliver structured internal audits in line with this standard.
