

# City & Guilds 6150-05 Emergency Rescue & Recovery of Casualties in Confined Space

## Introduction

The City & Guilds Training Scheme 6150 is the water industry standard. All Water companies participated in the formulation of this scheme to ensure that training quality is consistent and accepted nationally.

CG6150-05 is a course in Emergency Rescue and Recovery of Casualties in Confined Space, which runs for 2 days. All delegates must have completed the High Risk Confined Space course (CG6150-03) before attending this training. Delegates are able to combine all elements of both courses in one block booking where available.

## Course Duration

SSG are able to offer this course in partnership with Devon and Somerset Fire and Rescue Service over 2 days.

## Who Should Attend

This course is designed for those who are part of or in the process of forming a dedicated rescue team.

## Course Requirements

- Minimum age of 18
- Medically fit and healthy
- Delegates must hold a valid C&G 6150-03 'Working in High Risk Confined Space' qualification and must be in receipt of their certification at the time of the course.

## Course Programme

Assessment is by practical observation and written test, and will include:

- Rescue planning
- Alternative strategies for effective rescue
- Tactical decision making
- Operational procedures
- Essential casualty evacuation
- Practical, scenario based training



### Certification and Assessment

All persons who successfully complete the practical and written test will receive a City & Guilds 6150-05 Certificate in Emergency Rescue and Recovery of Casualties in Confined Space and a site Identity Card. The certificate is valid for three years.
