



Fire Safety Management



Introduction

The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 requires the 'Responsible Person' to safeguard the occupants of the building against fire and establish a fire safety management system.

This course provides attending delegates with an underpinning knowledge of current fire legislation and guidance together with advice on how to establish an effective fire safety management system that will integrate with their current H&S management systems; where applicable.

It will introduce the Regulatory Reform Fire Safety Order 2005 and explain how by utilizing available Reference Guides, British Standards and Approved Codes of Practice, the Manager can work towards satisfying the legal requirements for the protection of relevant persons within or about the workplace.



Course Duration

Who Should Attend

This course is designed for delegates with at least a basic understanding of the principles of fire safety. It is suitable as an introduction to fire risk management systems. This course is suitable for managers of sites, housing managers, estates surveyors, facilities managers, building owners, or fire or health and safety managers.

- The chemistry of fire; including the fire triangle and classes of fire
- Fire prevention techniques including housekeeping, storage and safe working practices
- Fire precautions, including compartmentation, fire detection, fire escape strategies and extinguishers
- The maintenance of fire precautions within the workplace
- Fire safety management
- Fire risk assessment process
- Emergency planning and drills
