

NEBOSH National General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety GC2 & 3 Only



Introduction

The NEBOSH National General Certificate is the most widely held health and safety qualification of its kind in the UK. Many people take the NEBOSH National General Certificate as a first step in a career in health and safety. It provides a valuable overview, and is a sound basis for further professional study.



Course Duration

Seven days including the revision day, practical and written exams. This course is also available to distance learners with a view to course delivery over a period of time which suits the learner.

In addition to classroom based study, delegates will be expected to undertake a minimum of 30 hours private study time.



Who Should Attend

Suitable for managers, supervisors and staff from all types of organisations making day-to-day decisions at work who need a broad understanding of health and safety issues and to be able to manage risks effectively.

Course Programme

The NGC1 Unit - Management of Health and Safety is the foundation module for any delegates wishing to achieve this and other NEBOSH qualifications.
